The Canton Chamber of Commerce, citizens, businesses and the *Sioux Valley News* welcome you to Canton, a town where you can live, work and play!

We invite you to take a few minutes and read through the Canton Visitor and New Resident guide to learn about Canton, South Dakota and the great services, parks, amenities and fun things to do while you are here.

Canton, a town of 3,100, is home to hundreds of businesses, a school district that consistently ranks above average in educational markers, a growing and updated infrastructure to support growth and as county seat of Lincoln County, Canton plays an important role in providing services, entertainment, employment and education to residents, visitors and businesses.

The city of Canton was organized in 1861 when permanent settlers first came to Canton. Canton is one of the oldest communities in the Dakota Territory. The name Canton was chosen because it was believed the town site was located directly opposite of Canton, China, and organizers thought the Chinese spelling meant Gateway. Canton was known as Gate City for many years. In 1868, many Norwegian immigrant families moved to Canton to settle, which more than doubled the population of Lincoln County.

Only 11 years after the establishment of Canton, in August of 1872, the first issues of the *Sioux Valley News* were published. It was one of the first newspapers published in the Dakota Territory. The original press was owned by Col. Arthur Linn, who brought the press to Canton by wagon. The railroads in Canton have always been key to the agricultural



business. The railroads are still in use today and continue to be critical to agricultural in Canton. The original depot building has been restored and is home to the Canton Visitor Center and Chamber office. The center is open Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

In 2018 a Performing Arts Center, The Canton Barn, a wedding destination with a very unique country setting, Gate City Events Center and Rental House, which includes an indoor pool and home-style lodging, a new campground and more new businesses setting up shop in downtown Canton and more!

In total there are around 200 businesses, a majority of them locally owned and operated, helping support the base of Canton's economy. These businesses, employees, owners and customers help shape a healthy economy in Canton that is unique being within 20 minutes of South Dakota's largest city, Sioux Falls.

Canton's Rich Railroad History

Trains were the choice of travel through the 19th and early 20th centuries; Canton was more than a stop on the route, it was a destination for many travelers. The Canton Depot Museum brings together the rich history of Canton's Norwegian heritage through a partnership with the Sons of Norway and the Depot Foundation.

The Canton Depot Visitor Center and Museum originally sat in the middle of the tracks south of Laurie's Cafe. Maynard Molstad had a vision to preserve the depot and with the partnership of the Sons of Norway, the Depot was moved, restored, and completed over the years at its current location at 600 W. 5th St.

In the Depot, visitors will find history of the railroad and its impact on Canton, local history of Canton and its citizenship and original artifacts related to the railroad and town's history. The Canton Chamber of Commerce is located in the south building of the Depot, along with meeting space for the community. The basement has been finished and is utilized for catering, meetings, get-togethers, receptions, birthdays and so much more.

During community celebrations and special events the Museum is open for guests to visit. The annual Depot Days, held in the summer, is also a fun time and a chance to celebrate the railroad's influential history in Canton.

Canton Public Library

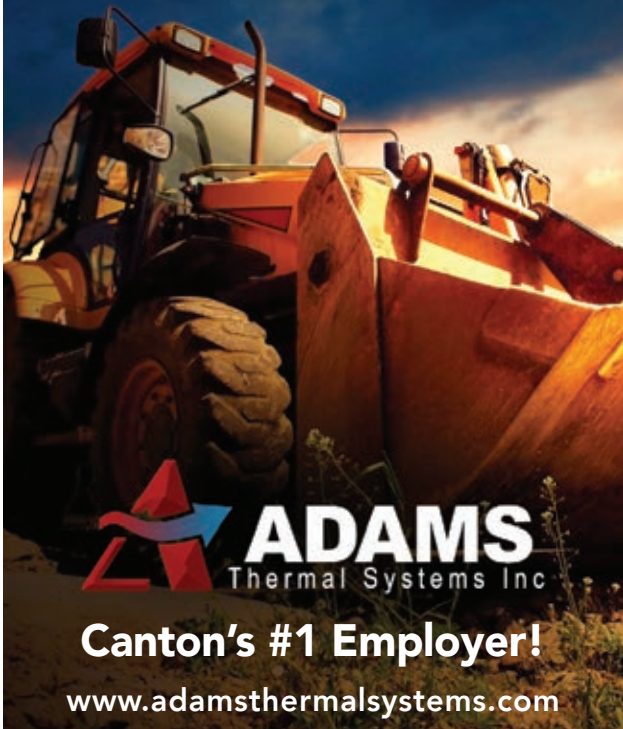


The Canton Public Library was built in 1989 in the former location of the historic Bandshell in Jack Fox Park in an effort to create a larger library space for the public. Prior to the library's completion, the facility had been located at the Canton Carnegie Public Library on the southwest corner of 4th Street and Lincoln, where the building still stands today.

Today, the library regularly hosts the annual Summer Reading Program for young readers which features reading incentives for young readers, activities, special guests and more. Other popular events include weekly Story Time for children, Tail Waggin' Tutors, movie showings, Mr. Twister, and occasional book club meetings for adults.

The Canton Public Library also serves as a historical archive for the Canton area. Several different historical displays are featured year-round with artifacts and memorabilia from Canton's earliest days, as well as artwork from various local artists.

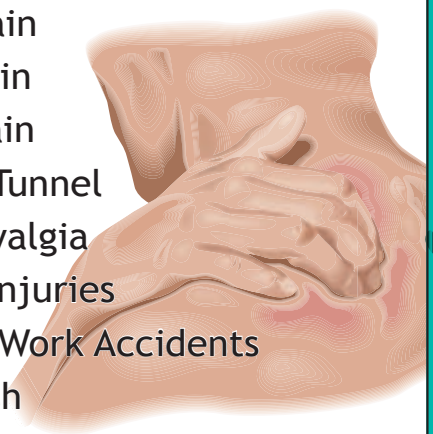

Aside from its excellent facilities and high quality of its teaching staff, several other attributes set the Canton School District apart from other districts in the area. The following features are just a few examples:

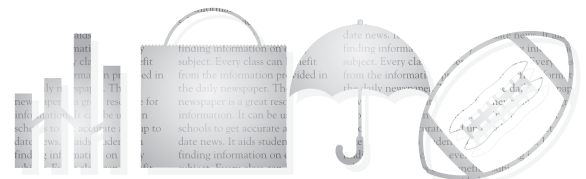

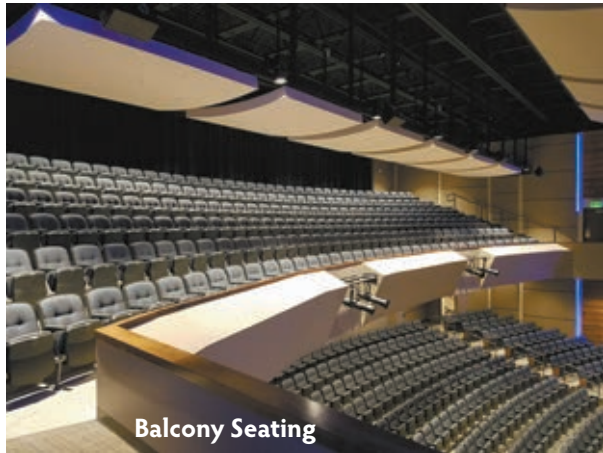

Performing Arts Center

After over three years of planning, Canton's new prestigious Performing Arts Center was officially completed during the fall of 2018. The vote to approve the \$7.2 million construction bond was passed in June 2016 by district voters, and the project broke ground in May 2017.

Complete with an impressive stage and seating for 1,000 people, the new facility pays homage to the old auditorium in the former Canton High School, which was demolished in 1998 when significant structural damage required a new school to be built. "This project not only restores a piece of our school district's history that was lost, but secures the legacy of Fine Arts in our community," said Terry Gerber, Superintendent of the Canton School District, at an open house event in November 2018.

In addition to the main stage, the auditorium is complete

with an orchestra pit and two side stages, with dressing rooms, costume storage, a makeup room, a scene shop and additional storage located behind the stage. The ground level has seating for 760 people as well as another 240 people in the balcony.

The first event to be held in the PAC was the annual Veteran's Day Program, held on the 100th anniversary of Armistice Day. The facility also became the new home to all of the Canton School District's musical performances, including band and choral concerts, elementary concerts, and performances by the Canton Theater Department, including their first musical performance in the PAC, "Chicago."

Several other local organizations that have since utilized the Performing Arts Center for their special events include the Carnegie Center for the Arts, Culture and Education, the Miss Canton Pageants, the annual Memorial Day program, and several others.


Since its debut, the facility has served as a new beacon of light in the community for the Fine Arts, and will continue to represent the talent in Canton for many generations to come.

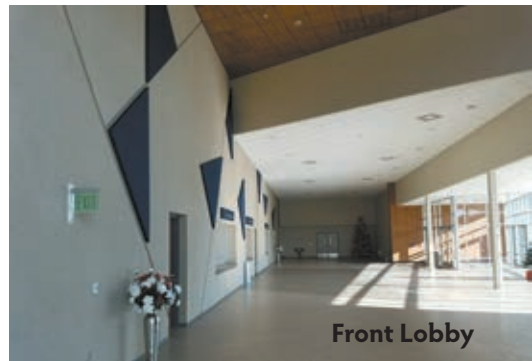

Newton Hills State Park Events, Entertainment & More

A quiet, shady campground draws thousands of campers each year to Newton Hills. Campers can stay in the campground, in one of eight camping cabins or the group lodge.

The four-bedroom lodge is a favorite of large groups, particularly of families and groups of hunters or anglers. The lodge features two full baths, a full kitchen, an upper deck and lower walk-out patio. The lodge is furnished. Guests need to bring bedding, bath towels, personal items and food. Contact the park for more information.

After a day on the trail, horseback riders can head for the park's equestrian camp. The trail camp provides facilities for both day and overnight park users, which include vault toilets, water, large parking areas and day and overnight horse corrals.

If you are planning a family get-together, the park has 20' x 20' and 20' x 40' canopy tents available for rent. Please contact the park office for price/details.

Nature Observation

If you're interested in bird-watching, Newton Hills is definitely the place to be. More than 200 species of birds visit the area each year. White-tailed deer, wild turkeys marmots, rabbits, red and gray fox and squirrels are also found within the park.

Archery deer and turkey hunting are allowed within the park during designated seasons, but uncased bows and firearms are not allowed within the park's campgrounds and picnic areas. Please refer to the hunting handbook for

more information. State parks are closed to hunting from May 1 through Sept. 30 of each year

A six-mile multi-use trail leads through dense oak and basswood forest. Woodland Trail is listed in the registry of National Recreation Trails.

Sioux River Folk Festival

Newton Hills hosts a popular musical concert in conjunction with the Friends of Traditional Music. The Sioux River Folk Festival, is held annually on the first weekend in August. To learn more about the Sioux River Folk Fest and the Friends of Traditional Music, please visit the website, www.fotm.org.

FestiFALL/CandleLight Walk

Held each year on the first Saturday in October.

The popular FestiFALL event is attended annually by people of all ages, and features many family activities including arts and crafts booths, kid's games and bluegrass music. Visitors are encouraged to bring in their own decorated or carved pumpkins for judging.

The Candlelight Walk leads visitors along 2.2 miles of candle-lit trail through the deep woods of Newton Hills. The trail will be solely lit by candles and carved pumpkins. Throughout the weekend, campers are encouraged to decorate their campsites with a fall theme.

Nature & Recreational Programs

Newton Hills hosts an array of interpretive, educational and recreational activities during the summer season from

Open House Weekend through Labor Day. Each program is geared for families with young children and will expose participants to the various natural and cultural features of the park and surrounding area. All of the programs are free to the public; however, a valid park entrance license is required on all vehicles entering the state park.

The amphitheater in the campground is the featured location for most of the programs. At least 3 programs are held every Saturday afternoon. Educational films are presented Friday and Saturday evenings at 9 p.m. The park also hosts a non-denominational church service every Sunday morning at 9 a.m.

The park also has a number of exciting lawn games, horseshoes, game balls, fishing poles, etc., to check out at the welcome center. GPS units are also available to go and search the park and find a geocache...what's a geocache? Check out www.geocaching.com for more information.

GOOD EARTH STATE PARK AT BLOOD RUN

Good Earth State Park boasts a state-of-the-art Visitors Center. In this Center you will find collections of artifacts, an authentic replica of a Native American lodge, displays, interpretive areas, a movie theater and hundreds of other items on display. After the dedication on May 19, 2017 the Center was opened to the public after much anticipation. Work completed over the past year also includes several miles of trail improvement, outdoor picnic areas, paved parking, a new entrance just North of Springdale Lutheran Church and much more.

This is the largest Oneota cultural site discovered to date in the upper Midwest. There are two other significant Oneota cultural sites located respectively in southwest Iowa and central Missouri.

There are several different displays that have been incorporated into the visitors center museum area. A full-size reproduction of a lodge

that would have been found during the Oneota occupation gives a glimpse of how the homes were built and what it may have been like inside the lodge. The lodge was built using traditional materials, from the buffalo hides that cover it to the sinew used to secure the poles holding the lodge together.

As Game, Fish and Parks, tribal representatives and others worked on the exhibits, movie and other features, it became evident Good Earth S.P. would utilize more than just the visual sense.

Walking into the visitors center, guests will be greeted by a smoky, light aroma that immediately reminds one of tanning hides or campfires. Walking from the parking lot to the East entrance of the Visitors Center gives you the opportunity to hear birds, animals and the blowing prairie grasses. The smells of the outdoors also fill the air as more and more land is reclaimed into prairie. The



ability to touch gives all ages an appreciation for the way of life hundreds of years ago.

A special feature that has been months in the making is a 20 minute film that will loop during the day. This film, called "Awakening the Silent City" is a full-feature professional film shot on-site. The title goes back to a map drawn by R.F. Pettigrew, in which he referred to the settlement as the Silent City.

The amount of historical

facts presented in the film alone will give visitors a background to pull from as they move through the Center.

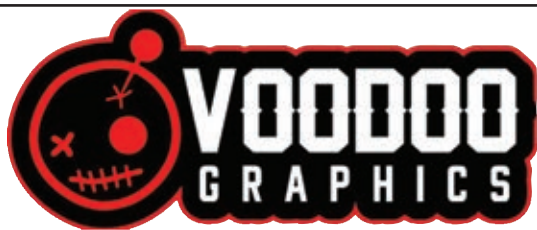

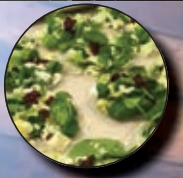

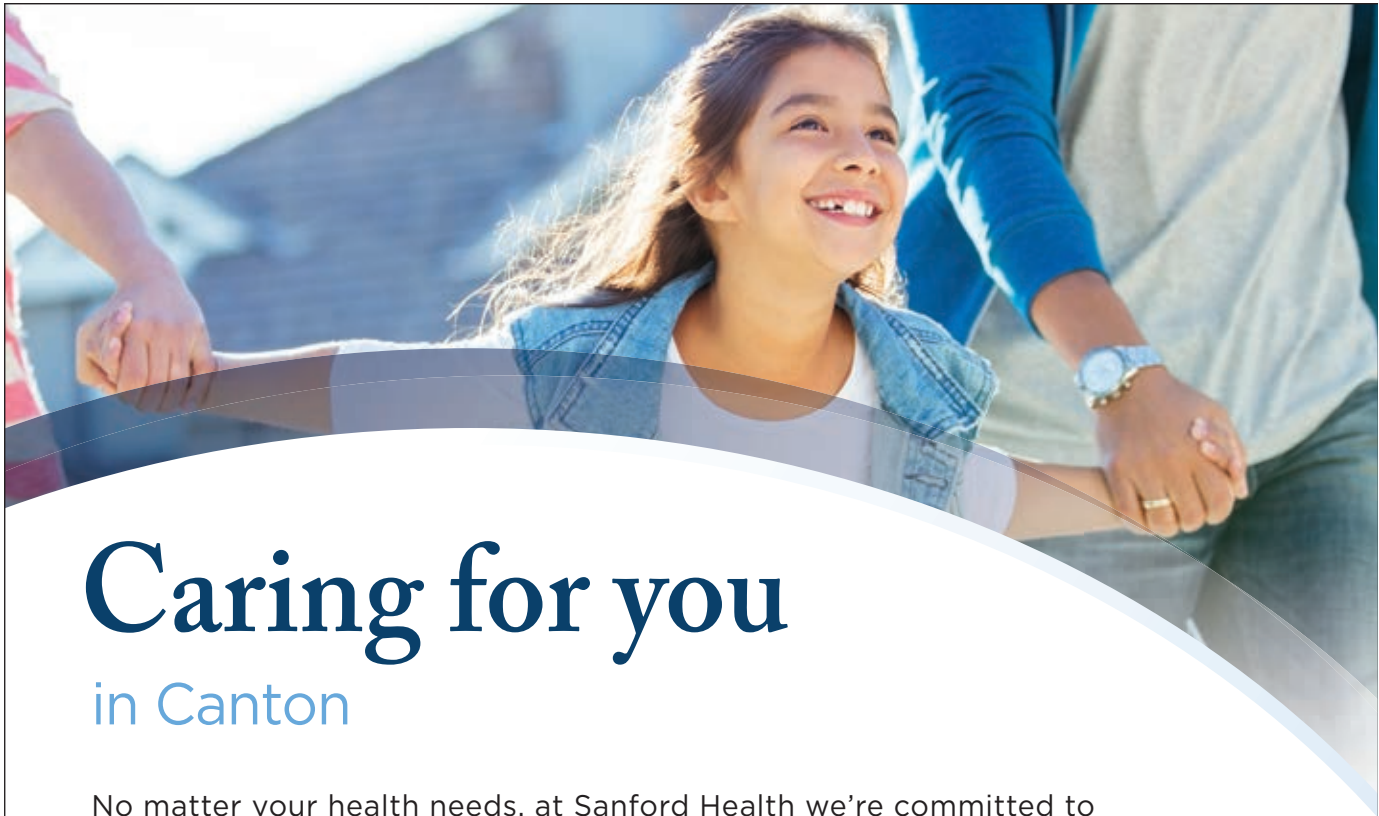
